GAMES ROOM

ADVANCED TAP* WITH BPAC

Participants will engage in an advanced tap class where they will continue developing their tap skills. Tap class is a great way to utilize musical and mathematical skills while being physically active. Open to participants enrolled in tap with BPAC during Be Me 2022-23, or with prior tap experience.

ARTVENTURES

Here we will explore different elements (line, shape and color) through 2D and 3D projects. Each week we will look at all the ways artists (from the past and present) have used these elements and how we can create new art.

HOMEWORK HELP

A quiet, supervised space where participants can work on homework and read quietly. Participants will also have access to our lending library, where they can check out books throughout the semester.

LOW ROPES & TEAMBUILDING

Participants will engage in fun and physically challenging low-ropes and teambuilding activities that not only improve and build upon gross-motor skills, but also cultivate skills like communication, leadership, teamwork, persistence, and more!

BUBBIE'S KITCHEN*

JAZZ DANCE* WITH BPAC \$400

One of the most popular and well known forms of dance. Jazz dance includes strength, flexibility and conditioning technique and progressions including turns, kicks and leaps.

INSTRUCTIONAL SOCCER*

GROUP PIANO

In this instructional series, students will get an introduction to piano. In a class of eight, your child will learn basic piano skills such as note values, tempo, finger placement, and melodies. All participants will have the opportunity to perform musical selections during our Be Me showcase!

FULL STEAM AHEAD

Participants will engage in hands-on STEAM explorations through a variety of activities including solving STEAM mysteries, exploring the science of superpowers, becoming pirates, and more!

CHORUS

Join our Shirim chorus and learn about musical traditions from around the world as well as how choral music works. All participants will have the opportunity to perform musical selections during our Be Me showcase!

YOUR HERO'S JOURNEY

This class is for the student that would "rather just draw their own thing". Using Joseph Cambell's story structure, participants will learn the fundamentals of the Hero's Journey. Applying what we've learned, participants will construct their own Hero from origin stories to fatal flaws. Whether it is a film, a comic book, or an epic poem, participants will finish this course with a physical copy of their very own Hero's Journey.

SENSATIONAL SENORY ART

Let's get messy! In this class, little artists will be encouraged to explore a variety of artistic mediums and create art using all of their senses.
